

# Suffix -ed

## Pronunciation

You may see the suffix '-ed' in the past tense of regular verbs, past participles and adjectives.

### Usage

The pronunciation of words ending in -ed depends on the **final sound** (not spelling) of the base word. Depending on the type of sound we can pronounce '-ed' as /ɪd/ /t/ or /d/.

/t/ after unvoiced consonants	/d/ after vowels and voiced consonants	/ɪd/ after /t/ or /d/

**Voiced consonants** are sounds that we make with the vocal cords vibrating alongside our mouth and breath.

### Voiced and unvoiced sounds

**Unvoiced consonants** are made without the vocal cords vibrating.

If you're not sure if a sound is voiced or unvoiced you can check by putting your hand on your throat.
